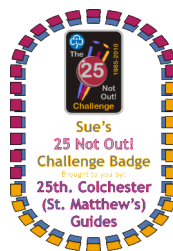
The 25th Not out Challenge badge

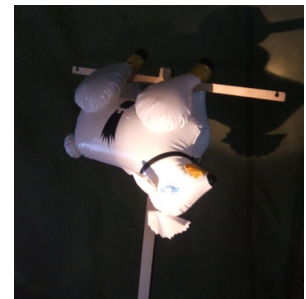
